### // The Opening Drive //

After not meeting for two years, St. Joe and Gull Lake meet for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in two weeks in the opening round of the playoffs. St. Joe won the game two weeks ago over the Blue Devils 54-14 at Dickinson Stadium. The Bears hold a 7-0 lifetime record against the Blue Devils and 2-0 all time in the playoffs. The Bears and Blue Devils first met in postseason play in 2006 at Richland Stadium with the Bears winning 14-0. Three years later they would meet again here at St. Joe with the Bears coming away with the 56-13 win, that game was exactly 11 years ago tonight.

### // The Bears //

St. Joe concluded the regular season with a 22-14 win at Battle Creek Lakeview. Griffin Shinrock had a pair of touchdowns, the first was a 32 yard pass from Troy Pratley, giving the Bears the lead at 14-7. His second came on a school record 95 yard kickoff return for a touchdown that gave the Bears the lead again at 22-14. Pratley opened the scoring on a 1 yard run in the opening quarter. Brennan Kerns and Malik Immoos each had an interception to end Lakeview's last two drives.

### // The Blue Devils //

Eric White accounted for Gull Lake's only touchdown of the first half, a 1-yard run that cut the Blue Devils deficit to 13-7 at halftime, but Portage Central would add a pair of third quarter touchdowns in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. Then Silas VanWormer scored on a 32-yard run to provide the final margin of 25-13. The loss drops Gull Lake to 0-6 (0-5 SMAC).

**THE LAST PLAYOFF MEETING – 10/30/09 – ST. JOSEPH 56, RICHLAND GULL LAKE 13 – DICKINSON STADIUM**

(St. Joseph) – Three years ago, St. Joe made their first playoff appearance since 1999 when the Bears traveled to Gull Lake, the Bears came out of that game with 14-0 win over the Blue Devils. Three years later, the Bears showed the Blue Devils that St. Joe football has come a long way since that first round matchup, as the Bears crushed Gull Lake 56-13 at Dickinson Stadium.

The Bears defense and a strong wind kept Gull Lake deep in their own territory in the first quarter. St. Joe got on the board first after the defense forced a three and out for Gull Lake, on the ensuing punt, Devonte Jones picked up the ball after bouncing off of a Bear defender and returned it 50 yards for the touchdown and a 7-0 Bear lead.

The defense would step up again on the Blue Devils next drive. Tyler Curtis caused a fumble which was recovered by Jeremy Rush at the Gull Lake 24 yard line, two plays later Tyler Curtis would take the handoff and scored from 12 yards out for a 14-0 St. Joe lead.

After another Gull Lake punt the Bears took just one play to make it 21-0 as Sean Guinane threw a 42 yard touchdown pass to Michael Carter. The Bears, at that point, only had a total of three offensive plays.

Still in the first quarter, Gull Lake punted again, St. Joe took 6 plays to find the endzone again as Joel Bergman caught a 19 yard touchdown pass to put the Bears up 28-0.

Gull Lake's offense finally was able to gain a first down in the Blue Devils first possession of the second quarter but it again resulted in a punt, which St. Joe turned into another touchdown as Devonte Jones scored his second touchdown of the game on a 25 yard run to put the Bears up 35-0.

St. Joe defense kept Gull Lake's offense bottled up and forced another three and out, the Bear offense turned it into another touchdown. Ty Taylor scored from 10 yards out and the Bears lead jumped to 42-0.

Gull Lake finally was able to cross midfield against some of the Bears substitutes on defense as Taylor Schultz scored on a 30 yard scramble to put the visitors on the board at 42-7.

The Bears didn't take long to get that score back as St. Joe capped of a 3 play 52 yard drive when Sean Guinane threw a 25 yard touchdown pass to Tyler Curtis to put the Bears ahead 49-7 at halftime.

The second half would be played under the MHSAA mercy rule. But the luck wouldn't chance for Gull Lake as the Blue Devils first two possessions of the second half were stopped by interceptions, the Bears would turn the second of the two into a touchdown as Josh Akins scored on a 10 yard run, and then proceeded to kick the extra point to put the Bears up 56-7. Akins kicked 8 extra points and kicked off 10 times for 534 yards.

With the clock quickly winding down, Gull Lake would close out the scoring as Schultz threw a 12 yard passing touchdown to Adrian Zuidweg. The point after was blocked by Micah Schoeplein.

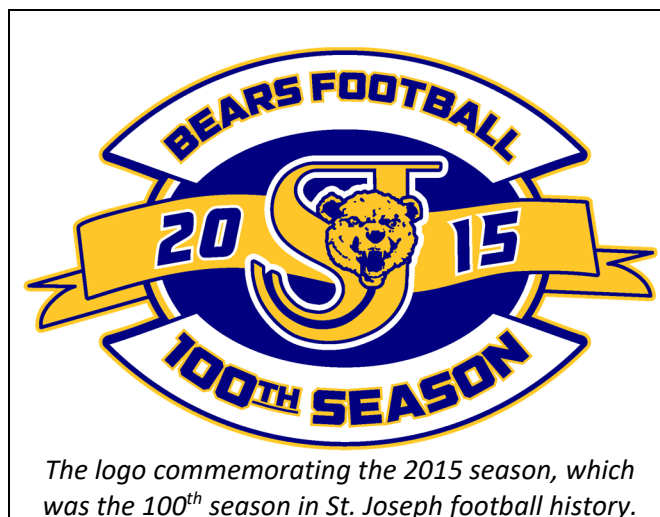

**THE BEAR TRADITIONS...****EARN YOUR NUMBERS**

When you look out on the field you will notice that many if not all of the Bears have numbers on the left side of their helmets. You may also notice that some may not. The numbers on the left side of the helmet must be earned. This is what is called Earning Your Numbers in the Saint Joseph Football program. Each week the varsity coaching staff discusses which players have earned their numbers. The criteria for earning your numbers are set by each senior class. Before every season each senior class develops what they believe are the behaviors of a champion. These behaviors are what are used for the criteria of earning your numbers. If a player's position coaches believe he is consistently exhibiting the behaviors of a champion he will be awarded his numbers. The player must maintain that consistency or he could have his numbers taken away and have to earn them back. The goal is for every player to Earn His Numbers. This tradition began in Coach Church's second year in 2012.

The resounding clang of a bell echoing through a fall night in St. Joseph is a beautiful thing. After every victory the Bears ring the victory bell with pride. If the win was at home the bell will be rung immediately following the handshake line. If the victory was earned on the road you will hear the bell ringing late at night as the Bears arrive home from a joyous bus trip. The bell was donated by the Kruse family in memory of their daughter Michelle Kruse. The tradition began in Coach John VanWagoner's 2nd year in 2003, the first season in the new Dickinson Stadium. A new bell was acquired prior to the 2018 season.

The Bears first home field wasn't located very far from their current home. Wells Field on State Street in St. Joseph served as the home for the Bears from 1913 to 1949. Near the end of its use, the wooden covered grandstands were in danger of collapse and parking was an issue for fans. So the when the St. Joe schools acquired the title of the parcel of land a block away from Wells Field, it was then decided the school would need to have a new stadium. The grandstands at Wells Field were torn down. Wells Field is still in use by area youth. It is the home for the St. Joseph Baseball Association.

**The first Dickinson Stadium**

In the mid 1940's the St. Joseph School system acquired the title to a 40 acre parcel of land known as the Dickinson Estate. The area is where the current high school now stands. Around that same time the citizens of St. Joseph recognized the need for a new athletic and recreation area when problems at Wells Field made it difficult to continue to use the facility. It was then that the St. Joe residents got the ball rolling for a new facility. After receiving numerous recommendations by various experts, the planning committee, commissioned architect Robert V. Knox to develop the sketches and conceptual drawings of the stadium. The Board of Education would take these plans to the various service clubs around St. Joseph to rally the community involvement in the project. Every group that were presented the plans went on record as supporting it. The voters overwhelmingly passed the \$170,000 bond proposal on July 25, 1949 for the new stadium and track. A little over a year later, on September 22, 1950, the original Dickinson Stadium opened. The original Dickinson Stadium held its last event on October 19, 2001. In the 51 year history of the stadium it was the home to thousands of events, including football games, track meets, soccer games, band competitions, and commencement ceremonies.

**The new Dickinson Stadium**

The idea for a new stadium came about when a commission was charged with reviewing and making recommendations on the future of the facilities of the St. Joseph Public School system for the next 30-40 years. After a review of the old stadium it was determined that to bring the stadium's aging and deteriorating steel support and infrastructure up to code would be a very expensive project. The commission visited newly constructed high schools around the Midwest and made recommendations for the St. Joe schools, including a new football stadium. In March of 2001 a plan for a bond proposal was presented to the St. Joe taxpayers, which not only included the new stadium, but also a new athletic fieldhouse and other various projects at the high school, and a new auxiliary gym, offices, library and orchestra room at Upton Middle School. The bond issue passed on September 25, 2001, less than a month later, the last game at the old Dickinson Stadium was played and demolition began.

While construction continued during the 2002 football season the varsity team played their "Home" games at Lakeshore's Al Stockman Stadium, Benton Harbor's Filstrup Field and at Bridgman High School. Upton Middle School was the home site for the JV and Freshmen teams. The stadium now also has an 8 lane running track, the old stadium had 7 and only 6 were useable. The first games were played on Thursday, September 4th, by the Freshman and JV teams who gave the stadium its first shakedown before the Grand Opening a week later. The official dedication was prior to the game between St. Joseph and Kalamazoo Central, which St. Joe won 34-13. The pregame ceremony included a fly-over by a US Air Force A-10 fighter jet. Less than a year after the opening, the new Dickinson Stadium had the honor of hosting country music and TV star Reba McEntyre for a performance benefiting Harbor Habitat for Humanity. The concert was part of Reba's 2004 tour which was sponsored by Whirlpool Corporation. The concert was held in front of a sold out crowd of over 6,500 on July 20, 2004.

The scoreboard from the previous Dickinson Stadium, installed in 1998 was saved and relocated before being replaced prior to the 2016 season. The new scoreboard features a full color LED screen that shows live stats as the game progresses, videos, and enhanced animations. In 2018, thanks to a donation by the Upton Family, the playing surface was converted to artificial turf, prompting slight name change to Steve Upton Field at Dickinson Stadium.



**SEASON SUMMARIES – 9/18/20 – ST. JOSEPH 46, KALAMAZOO CENTRAL 13 – DICKINSON STADIUM**

*(St. Joseph) – It's been said that good things come to those who wait. For the 2020 St. Joseph Bears, a good thing did happen after the first three weeks of the season were cancelled due to COVID-19.*

*The Bears defeated Kalamazoo Central 46-13 at Steve Upton Field at Dickinson Stadium with Troy Pratley doing his best "David" and defeating the Giants.*

*Pratley got the Bears on the scoreboard on the opening drive of the season, leading St. Joe on a 73 yard 10 play drive that concluded with a 2 yard touchdown run from Pratley. Reese Uzelac, the granddaughter of former St. Joseph and current Berrien Springs head coach Elliot Uzelac, added the point after to put St. Joe up 7-0. Uzelac becomes the first female varsity player in the 105 year history of the St. Joseph football program.*

*Kalamazoo Central gained 6 yards before being forced to punt the ball back to St. Joseph. The Bears then went on another long time consuming drive. This one went 73 yards and required 17 plays and 6:16 off the clock, again being capped off by a short run by Troy Pratley. Kalamazoo Central would be penalized before the point after attempt, giving St. Joe a short field for the PAT and a run by Conner Savenas for the 2 points conversion gave St. Joe a 15-0 lead after the first quarter.*

*Kalamazoo Central would be forced to punt on their next drive and a bad snap on the punt provided a short field for the offense to go back to work. Five plays later Pratley would run for his third score of the game and the PAT by Uzelac pushed the Bears lead to 22-0.*

*Later in the 2nd quarter, Max Taylor hit a field goal from 39 yards out to put the Bears up 25-0.*

*Kalamazoo Central would find the scoreboard with 1:15 left in the half on an 11 yard run from Jaden Blanchard, Carter Vonk blocked the point after kick and St. Joe had the lead at 25-6, which was the score at the half.*

*St. Joe again found the scoreboard just passed the midway point of the third quarter when Savenas scored on a 2 yard run and the PAT had the lead for St. Joe at 32-6.*

*A Kalamazoo Central fumble two plays later was returned for a touchdown by Joey Siccarello, but a penalty flag nullified the return, but the Bears still had the ball deep inside Kalamazoo Central territory. It took just one play for Pratley to find Griffin Shinrock in the endzone for the touchdown reception. Uzelac added the extra point, even while being knocked down for a roughing the kicker penalty against Kalamazoo Central and the Bears went up 39-6.*

*Pratley again found the endzone early in the fourth quarter as he scored his 4th rushing touchdown of the night from a yard out and with the PAT, St. Joe went up 46-6, starting the MHSAA "mercy rule."*

*Kalamazoo Central figured out their offense worked giving the ball to their running back Blanchard. who carried the ball 50 of the 60 yards of the drive, except the last 10, when his teammate Andre Tarver scored from 10 yards. The PAT was partially blocked but still good to provide the final margin of 46-13.*

*With the win. St. Joe improves to 1-0, and coach Andrew Pratley improves to 2-0 in season and home openers. The Bears are on the road for the next game at Okemos (0-1), while Kalamazoo Central is home to face Lakeshore (0-1).*

**SEASON SUMMARIES – 9/25/20 – ST. JOSEPH 34, OKEMOS 13 – OKEMOS HS FOOTBALL STADIUM**

*(Okemos) – The first road trip of the season for the Bears was also the longest as St. Joe faced Okemos for the first time.*

*Just like in the opening game, St. Joe scored the first time they touched the ball. After a long return on the opening kickoff by Griffin Shinrock, the Bears offense started the drive on the Okemos 45 yard line. Eight plays later Troy Pratley scored on a 1 yard run, combined with the extra point from Reese Uzelac, the Bears took a 7-0 lead.*

*(St. Joseph) – After a win on the road at Okemos a week ago. St. Joe returned home to face an old rival, an inexperienced Portage Central team. Portage Central playing with their full roster for the first time this season after a positive COVID-19 test prompted them to forfeit their opening game against East Lansing, and more than a dozen players and coaches missing their contest against Battle Creek Lakeview while under quarantine.*

*Portage Central took full advantage of their excitement of getting on the field, the Portage Central defense forced St. Joe to a turnover on downs, starting their opening possession on the St. Joe 47-yard line. Six plays later Devin Porter scored the first points for the Mustangs this season when he ran for an 18-yard touchdown, with the PAT, Portage Central had a 7-0 lead. This marked the first time St. Joe had not led and the first time the opponent scored first.*

*St. Joe would turn the ball over on downs again on the next possession. Then the two teams would trade turnovers on consecutive plays. Pikkart would fumble on the first play, however the Mustangs would recover their own fumble, but Brennan Kerns sealed the St. Joe victory when he intercepted Pikkart on the next play. St. Joe would take a knee on the next three plays and completed the comeback for a 20-13 win.*

*The win improves the Beard record to 3-0, while Portage Central falls to 0-3. St. Joe now prepares for rivalry week as the Bears will next travel to Lakeshore next Friday night.*

**SEASON SUMMARIES – 10/9/20 – LAKESHORE 26, ST. JOSEPH 0 – AL STOCKMAN STADIUM**

(Stevensville) — Lakeshore's defense was so good Friday, it rarely had to stay on the field for very long.

The Lancers dominated rival St. Joseph 26-0, forcing eight turnovers and holding the Bears to just five yards rushing in the Southwestern Michigan Athletic Conference game.

"Our defense was lights out," said Lakeshore coach Denny Dock. "Holy cow did we play well. We played so well on defense. And for a while, we played really good on offense."

St. Joseph won last season's matchup, snapping an eight-game Lakeshore win streak in the rivalry.

"I'm happy for our guys," Dock said. "They wanted that trophy back, and they couldn't wait to get it."

Lakeshore (3-1 SMAC, 3-1) took a 3-0 lead late in the first quarter on a 36-yard Tyler Gates field goal, set up by a 38-yard run by Treyjen Keim. St. Joseph (2-1, 3-1) lost a fumble and threw an interception on its two drives.

The Lancers weren't able to score again until Keim's 10-yard run with 3:51 left in the half, as two second-quarter drives ended in turnovers deep in St. Joseph territory.

Quarterback JJ Bushu lost a fumble on the St. Joseph 2-yard line, recovered by Garrett Kiser. The Bears moved the ball near midfield with a 40-yard pass from Troy Pratley to Griffin Shinrock, but eventually were unable to convert a fourth-and-five.

Bushu was then intercepted by Preston Nichols at the St. Joseph 20, but the Bears gave the ball right back, as Riley Adams forced and recovered a Pratley fumble.

After the first Lancer touchdown, St. Joseph again gave the ball away immediately, as an attempted trick pass by Brennen Kerns was picked off by Grant Ruddell.

Aidan Jackson eventually ran in a touchdown from seven yards out to make it 17-0 at halftime.

"You can't turn the ball over eight times and beat anybody, let alone a good Lakeshore team," St. Joseph coach Andrew Pratley said. "It was an ugly night, and we've got to figure out a way to regroup and get better."

St. Joseph fumbled on its first two possessions of the first half. The first was recovered by Lakeshore and set up a two-yard TD run by Bushu. The Bears got the second one back, but not until the ball had rolled into the end zone for a safety.

Lakeshore controlled the ball and the clock much of the rest of the way. The Lancers finished with 288 rushing yards from a variety of carriers. Bushu led the way with 16 runs for 89 yards, and Jackson had 23 totes for 79 yards. Cage Davison had 61 rushing yards and Keim 55, each getting six attempts.

"Aidan ran pretty good again, ran hard," Dock said. "Treyjen had another good game. Cage, it was his first game back, I thought he had some nice runs. I think we blocked pretty good. But man, when we made a mistake, it was a bad one. We're not cancelling practice, I know that."

St. Joseph was forced to throw the ball in the second half, and although Troy Pratley threw for 197 yards, including 119 to Shinrock, he was picked off four times.

Keim, Bushu, Ruddell, Andrew Lies and Danny Vaughn all picked off passes. Evin Koeppe was a defensive standout with seven tackles, a sack, two tackles for loss and a fumble recovery.

Carter Vonk led the overworked St. Joseph defense with 11 tackles.

"I felt like the offense didn't ever give the defense a break, because they kept turning the ball right back over to them," coach Pratley said.

"We're moving on. We'll take next week and learn from this and get better. I think our kids are going to be plenty motivated to play that game next week."

*(St. Joseph) – After falling to Lakeshore the previous week, the Bears were looking to get back on the right track. St. Joe returned home to face Gull Lake, a team that has never won against St. Joe in the history of the matchup.*

*St. Joe would be forced to punt on their initial possession of the game, but would score touchdowns on 9 of the following 11 times the offense was on the field.*

*The Bears would strike first on a 1 play drive, after a pass interference penalty on Gull Lake, Troy Pratley would complete what he intended to do on the previous play when he connected with Griffin Shinrock for a 34 yard touchdown pass.*

*Gull Lake would punt on their next drive and St. Joe drove 78 yards in 9 plays, again ending with a Pratley to Shinrock touchdown pass, this from 8 yards out and the Bears had a 13-0 lead.*

*(Battle Creek) – St. Joseph clinched the top seed in the district and home field advantage for at least the first three rounds of the playoffs after Lakeshore's loss to DeWitt and the Bears 22-14 win at Battle Creek Lakeview.*

*St. Joe got on the board first after forcing a Lakeview missed field goal. St. Joe went on an 11-play 80 yard drive, ending with a 1-yard run by quarterback Troy Pratley on a quarterback sneak. However the snap on the point after sailed over his head and his pass attempt was incomplete, but the Bears took a 6-0 lead.*

*Lakeview would tie and then take the lead on the ensuing possession that continued into the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter. Quarterback Jaden Simonson scored on an 11 yard run, with the PAT good. Lakeview had the lead at 7-6.*

*St. Joe will open up the 2020 playoffs at Dickinson Stadium against 0-6 Gull Lake. The Bears defeated the Blue Devils 54-14 two weeks ago.*

Thanks to a school-record 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown by St. Joseph's Griffin Shinrock late in the fourth quarter, the Bears outlasted Lakeview, 22-14, in the regular-season finale in this Southwestern Michigan Athletic Conference football game Friday at Lakeview High School.

Here are five takeaways from the game.

**First Place On The Line**

Four teams went into the final week with the best record in the Southwestern Michigan Athletic Conference, including Lakeview and St. Joseph. So the winner would remain in first to end the season and earn a share of the title for the six-game shortened season.

St. Joseph clinched a share of the crown with the win, going to 5-1. Lakeview falls to 4-2.

"It doesn't hurt to finish in first. We'll take that for the kids," St. Joseph coach Andrew Pratley said.

**Less Than 100%**

Due to a combination of injuries, sickness and players said to be in quarantine due to COVID-19, Lakeview was without eight players Friday, including many of its offensive weapons in the backfield.

According to Lakeview officials, the players on quarantine were kept off the team due to an abundance of caution, as they were flagged because of contact tracing and not necessarily due to a positive test.

"It's one of those things, we did what we had to do and our kids played hard," Lakeview coach Jerry Diorio said. "We should be full strength next week. I saw a lot of positive things from the guys that played."

The reduced roster left running back Jaden Simonson to play quarterback for injured starter Aidan Rankin, and he kept the ball on most plays, providing the bulk of the Spartans' offense.

Simonson gave Lakeview its first touchdown on an 11-yard keeper to give the Spartans a 7-6 lead with 10:41 left in the first half.

Simonson later added another touchdown on another keeper from 8 yards out to make it 14-14 with 8:40 left in the fourth. That drive was set up by several solid runs by Zach Kucharczyk, a freshman getting playing time due to missing starters.

Simonson led Lakeview with 130 yards rushing on 27 carries.

"Jaden did some nice things. He is our backup quarterback, anyway, and he did what he had to do, running the ball from that spot," Diorio said.

**Defense On The Job Again**

Lakeview has been dominating games on the defensive side of the ball much of the season, and the Spartans were looking to control the contest with that unit again against St. Joseph.

Lakeview kept it a low-scoring contest throughout the first half, leading 7-6 at intermission. The Spartans stopped three drives in the second quarter with big defensive plays.

Kayleb Erskine had an interception on a slant pattern inside the 20-yard line with 7:43 left in the half. Lakeview then stopped St. Joseph on fourth down on the 18 with 1:41 left before halftime. The Bears still had one more shot at the end zone in the first half before Sawyer Shotwell intercepted the ball near the goal line with 16 seconds left.

Lakeview had one late defensive play to give the Spartans a chance in the final minutes of the game after a fumble recovery by Blake Daugin, but the home team could not do anything with the extra possession.

What offense St. Joseph did have came from its quarterback, Troy Pratley, as the Bears ran the option most of the night. Pratley had the first score of the game on a sneak from a yard out in the first quarter. Pratley later added a 32-yard touchdown pass to Shinrock to give the Bears a short-lived 14-7 lead in the third quarter. Pratley had 170 yards in the air and 28 more on the ground.
